



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July following on a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Two hundred and Twenty seven, Containing in Breadth East and West on Hurtleberry Street Sixty feet, and in Length North and South Two hundred and Thirty feet, Bounded Southward by Hurtleberry Street, Eastward by Lot Number Two hundred and Twenty Six, Northward by Raspberry Alley, and Westward by Lot Number Two hundred and Twenty Eight, Returned into the Secretary's Office the 23^d day of September 1774 for Zachariah Robbins by Warrant dated the 22^d Instant
