



Draught of a lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Carlisle in the County of Cumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Ninety, Situate on the South side of Pomfret Street between Hannover Street and Pitts Street Containing in Breadth East and West on the South side of Pomfret Street Sixty feet, and in length North and South Two hundred & forty feet, bounded Northward by Pomfret Street, Westward by Lot Number Eighty Two, Southward by a Twenty feet Alley, and Eastward by Lot Number Ninety Eight. Returned into the Secretarys Office the 1st day of October 1776 for William Feany by Warrant dated the 24th day of September 1776.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this Twenty first day of July 1910
