



By virtue of an Order dated the first day of August 1766 there was Surveyed on the 9th day of September 1766 unto Samuel Davis a certain Tract of Land situate on the Heads of a Run which empty into Frankstown Branch of Juniata above the Canoe place in the County of Cumberland called the Beaver Dam Tract containing Two hundred and ninety two Acres and a quarter and the usual allowance of six acres # Ct for Roads, &c. & Numb^d 42.
