



Surveyed the above described tract of land on the 6th & 7th of July in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and twelve for Joseph Marshall in pursuance of his warrant Nº 588 dated the 11th July 1785 (for 500^{ac}) Situate in Pine-creek township Lycoming County at the 23^d mile tree on a new road now opening from Jersey-Shore to the Allegany river including the headwaters of streams emptying into Pine and Young-womans creeks. containing Five hundred and Eighteen Acres one hundred and fifty seven perches and allowance of six p^r Cent.
