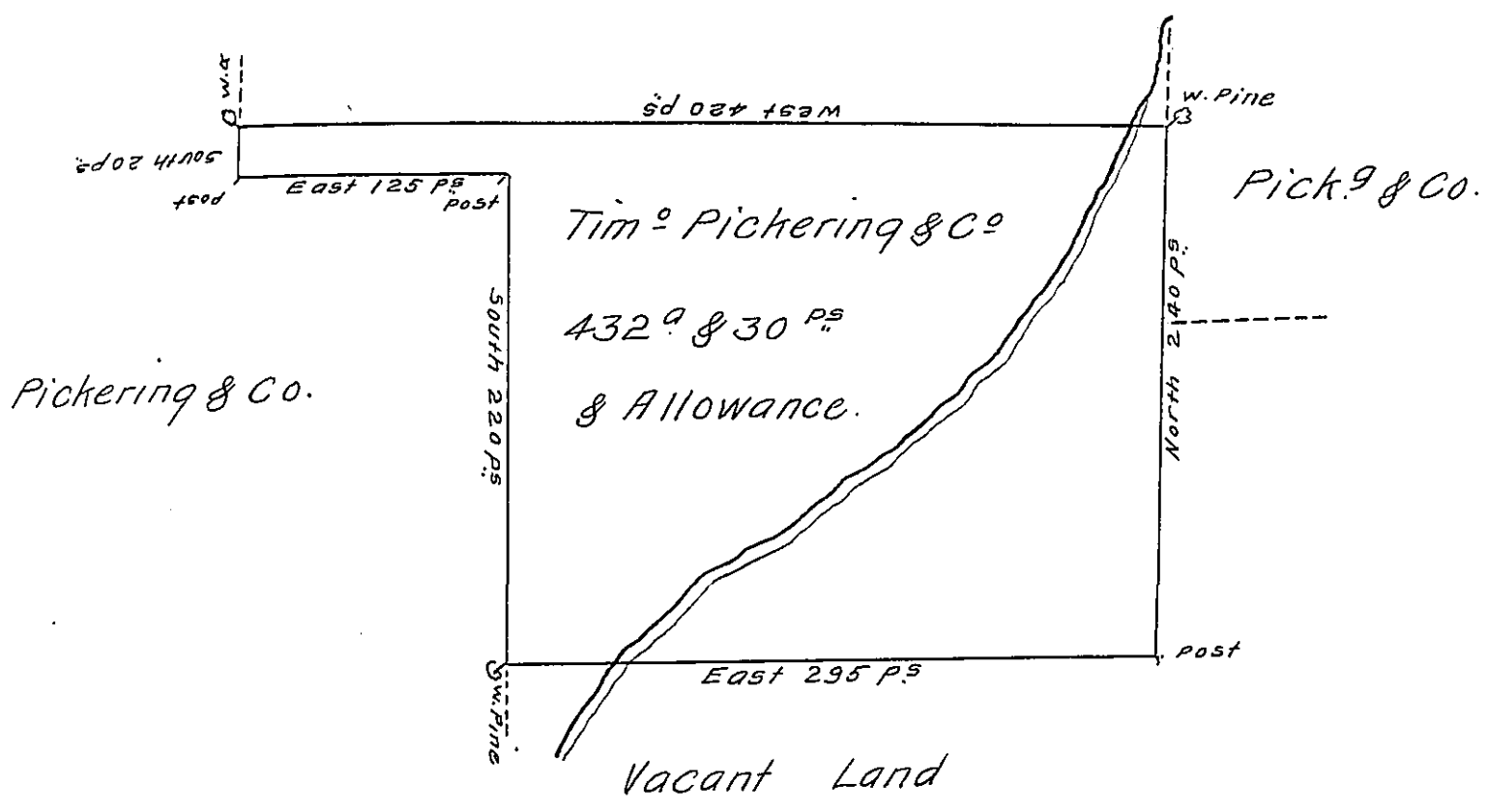


Pickering & Co. on No 322.



Surveyed for Timothy Pickering, Samuel Hodgdon, Duncan Ingraham Jun^r and Tench Coxe the ~~at~~ first day of June 1786 the above described tract of four hundred & thirty two Acres and thirty perches and Allowance of six th Cent ~~&c^a~~ (line obliterated) Creek adjoining their other lands in Northumberland County on Warrant for 400 Acres, No 422, dated the 17th day of May 1785.
