



A draught of a tract of land called the Elk Pasture (being part of a larger tract of the same name) situated on the North Branch of Conemough or other Creek nearly adjoining and above the mouth of it, including an old Indian Incampment between the main branches of the said Creek adjoining land of Joseph Meyer & Samuel Giffin & near land granted to James Wilson in Frankstown township in the County of Bedford containing two hundred and eighty seven acres and the usual allowance of six ~~per~~ cent. for roads &c.

Surveyed the 21st day of September 1773 for John Smallwood by virtue of a warrant dated the 23^d day of July in the same year, by
