



A draught of a tract of land called Stratford situate on Shamokin Creek in Berks County adjoining lands claimed by Jacob Reid and Michl Burger near the Gapp containing three hundred and four acres and one hundred and thirty five perches besides the usual allowance of 6  $\frac{1}{2}$  cent. for roads, surveyed the 26<sup>th</sup> June 1772 for George Michael Groff in pursuance of an order dated the seventh day of April 1769 - No 2960
