



By virtue of a warrant dated the eighth day of May 1753 surveyed the tenth day of June 1753 to Jacob Swartwood the above described tract of land situate on Shoemakers Creek in Upper Smithfield township, Northampton County containing forty six acres & a quarter of an acre with allowance of six percent.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this eleventh day of October 1911
