



By virtue of a warrant dated the 5<sup>th</sup> June 1792 surveyed the 7. September 1792 to Jacob Shimer the above described tract of land situate about three quarters of a mile from the mouth of the North branch of Pond Eddy Brook and about one mile and an half from Delaware River in Upper Smithfield township Northampton County containing one hundred acres and the allowance of six  $\frac{1}{2}$  cent &c.
