



A draught of a tract of land situate on the south side of Bald Eagle Creek on a Run call'd Davises Run in Bald Eagle township in the County of Northumberland, surveyed the 30<sup>th</sup> day of September 1784 for Thomas Strittet by virtue of a warrant dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July 1784 containing two hundred and twenty one acres with the allowance of six  $\frac{2}{3}$  ct for roads &c.
