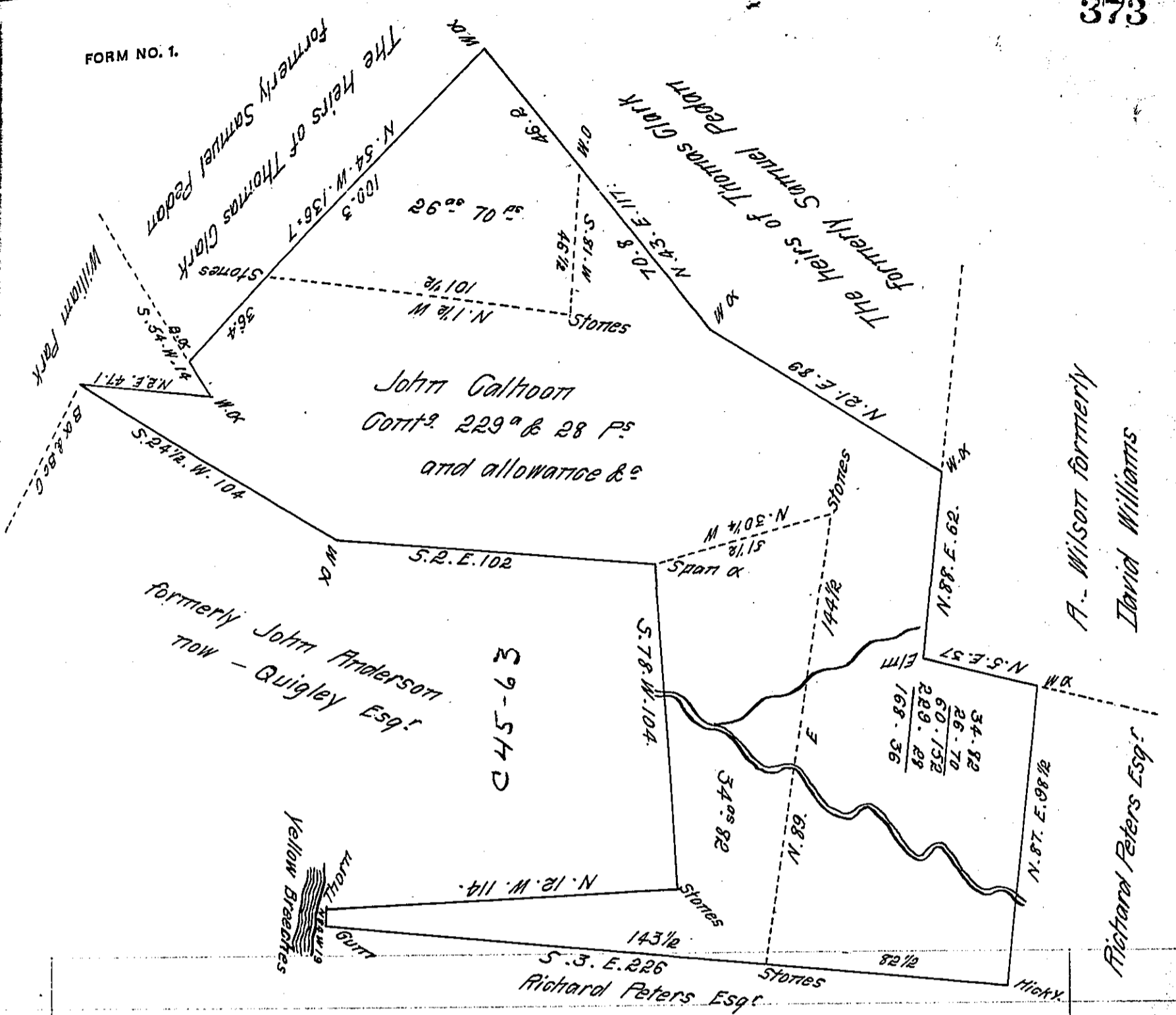

 day of December A.D. 1814.
