



A Draught of a Tract of Land called — Situate adjoining Land  
 Surveyed for Cortellius Slack on a Run that leads into the East side of the  
 North East Branch of Susquehanna above Old Wyoming called Beaver  
 Brook in the County of Northumberland containing Three hundred and  
 fourteen Acres besides the Usual Allowance of Six P<sup>t</sup> Cent for Roads &c<sup>o</sup>  
 Surveyed the 11<sup>th</sup> Day of November 1775 for John Evatis in pursuance of  
 a Warrant dated the 19<sup>th</sup> Day of August 1773.
