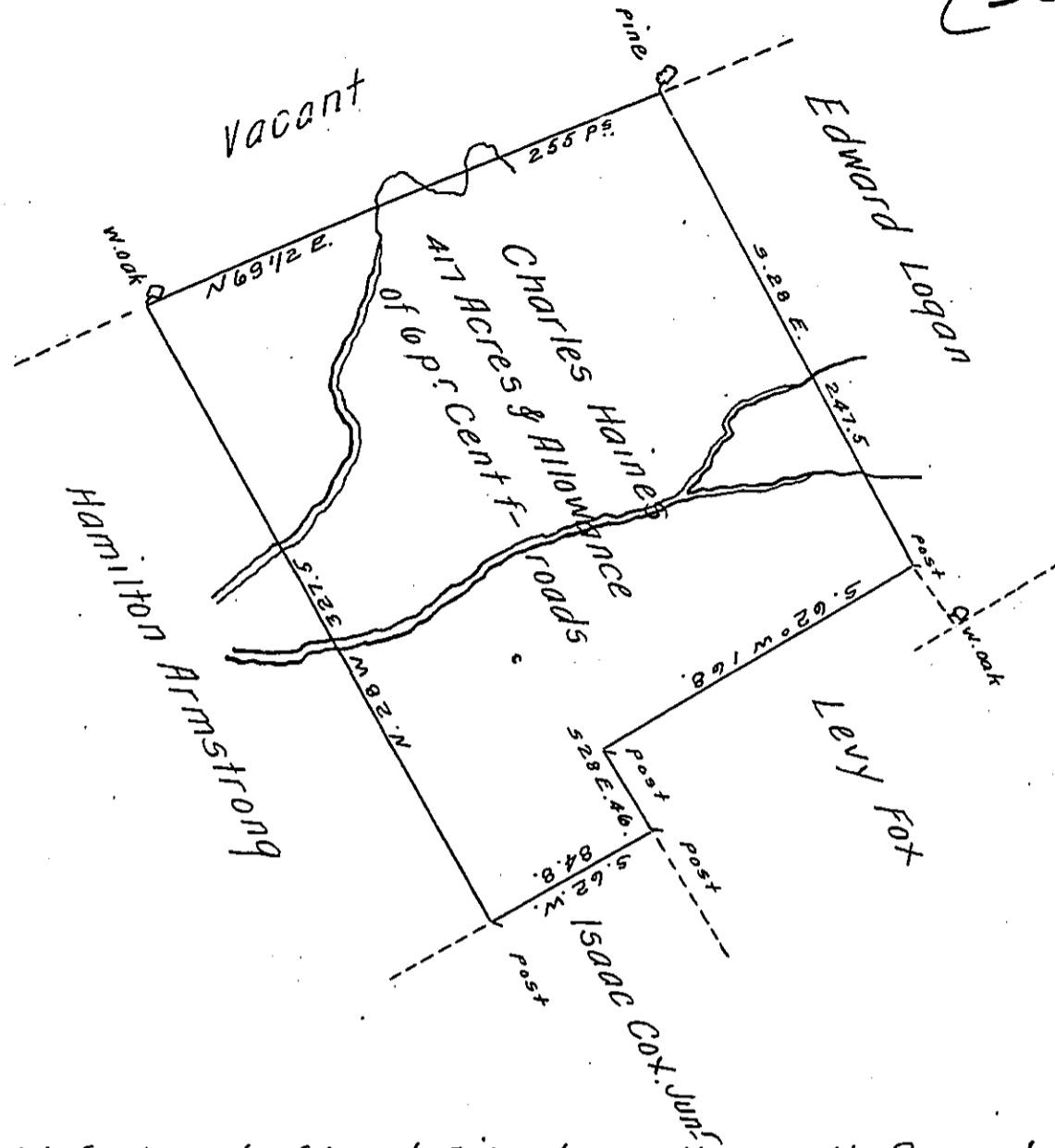

Containing four hundred and Seventeen acres and allowance of Six per cents for roads. Surveyed for Charles Haines the 20th day of November 1784 In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 1st day of July 1784. Resurveyed the 14th day of March 1812 In pursuance of an Order Issued by the Board of Property dated the 9th day of March 1812.
