



The Draught of part of two tracts of land Situate in Miles & Nipenose Townships Sugar Valley, formerly Northumberland, Now Centre & Lycoming Counties Containing together one hundred and thirty acres and forty perches and allowance of Six per Cent &c. being part of two tracts of land granted to Jabez M. Fisher & Joseph Turner by virtue of two warrants dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of February 1774. And Resurveyed the 11<sup>th</sup> day of June 1813. Clear of interference as to prior titles, by order of the Board of Property dated the 29<sup>th</sup> day of January A. D. 1813.

Note. The dotted lines show a Survey in the name of Francis Nichols, the date of the warrant & Survey not known, Supposed to be 1793 or 1794. The Residue of the Surveys in the name of Jabez M. Fisher & Joseph Turner, interferes with older Surveys Claimed by Joseph Anthony & Wistar. At the time of making the above Surveys, a Man by the name of McKison had a small improvement on them, but no Actual Settlement.
