



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Springfield situate on the Path leading from Bedford to Frankstown adjoining the West side and the North Easterly end of Col. Boquet's Survey and extending down the Run to within a few Perches of a Place known by the Name of the three Springs now in the Possession of Thomas Cook in the Township and County of Bedford. Containing three hundred and twenty one Acres and the usual Allowance of six  $\frac{1}{8}$  Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 3<sup>d</sup> Day of April 1775 for Joseph Cook in Pursuance of a Warrant Dated the 15<sup>th</sup> Day of February in the same Year by
