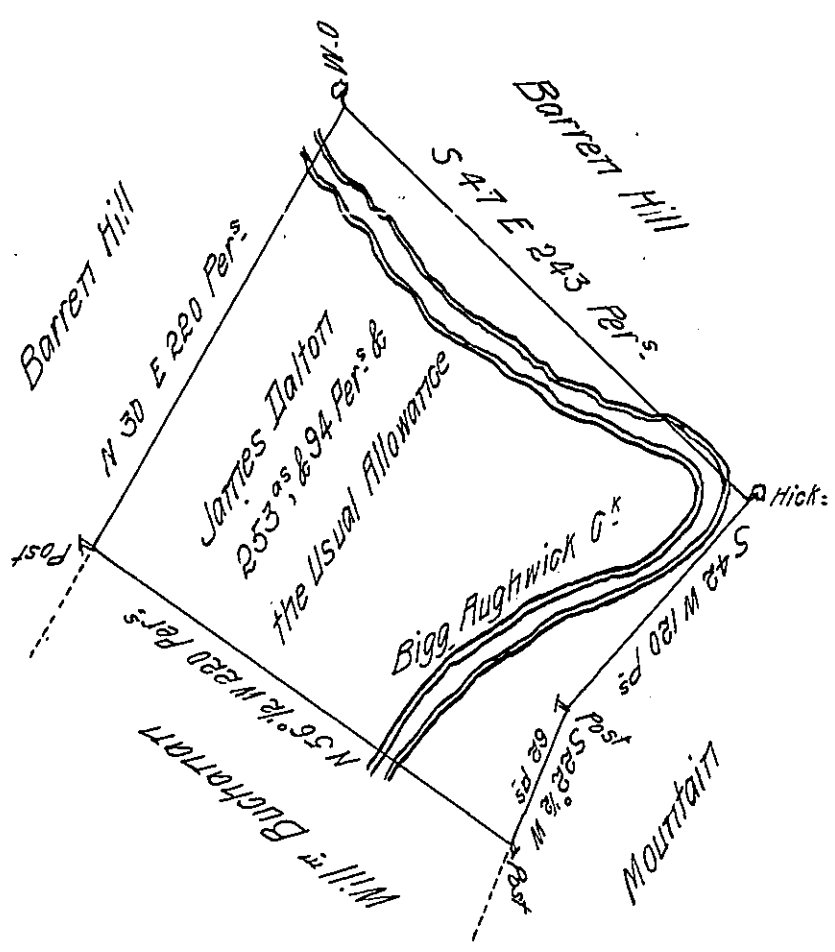


N.B: This Warrent was taken out for
