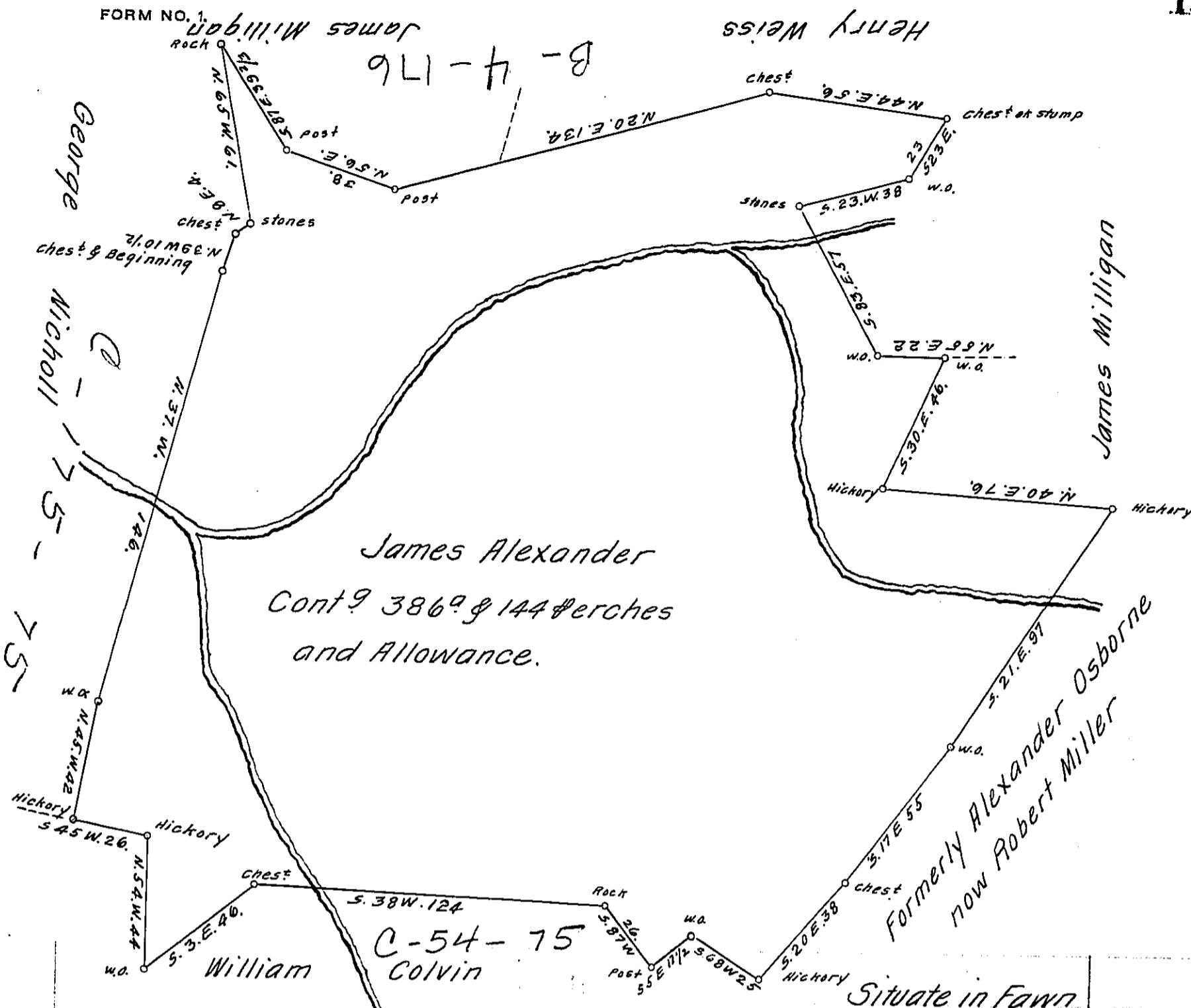

Viz one for 40<sup>9</sup> dated the 7<sup>th</sup> day of February 1787. and the other for 200<sup>9</sup> dated the 5<sup>th</sup> day of December 1785. and Resurveyed on the 19<sup>th</sup> of the 2<sup>d</sup> month 1793. And now at the request of the Present owners I am desired to make return of the draught as Calculated. examined &c. the 30<sup>th</sup> day of December A.D. 1809.
