From papers receivd of Simon Snider Esq^r Deputy Surveyor of Union County, it appears that the above discribed tract of land was surveyed on the 21st day of June 1800. by virtue of an order of resurvey granted to Daniel Smith Esq^r on the 16th day of July 1799, on Warrant granted to James Parkinson Dated 21st October 1784. Resurvey'd at the Request of the present ^{owners} this 22^d day of May 1816. Containing four hundred & twenty eight acres & one hundred & thirty perch and allowance of six per cent &c. Situate in Washington Township Lycoming (formerly Northumberland) County & bounded as above discribed -
