



A Draught of a tract of land situate on the south ^{side of} Nescopeck Creek adjoining land surveyed to David Logan in the Township of Sugar-leaf (formerly Northumberland now) Luzerne County Containing four hundred and thirty nine acres and eighty three perches and the usual allowance of 6 per Cent for Roads. Surveyed to Levy Fox the 21st day of November 1784 in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 1st day of July 1784 Resurveyed the 14th day of March 1812 in pursuance of an Order issued by the Board of Property dated the 9th day of March 1812 -
