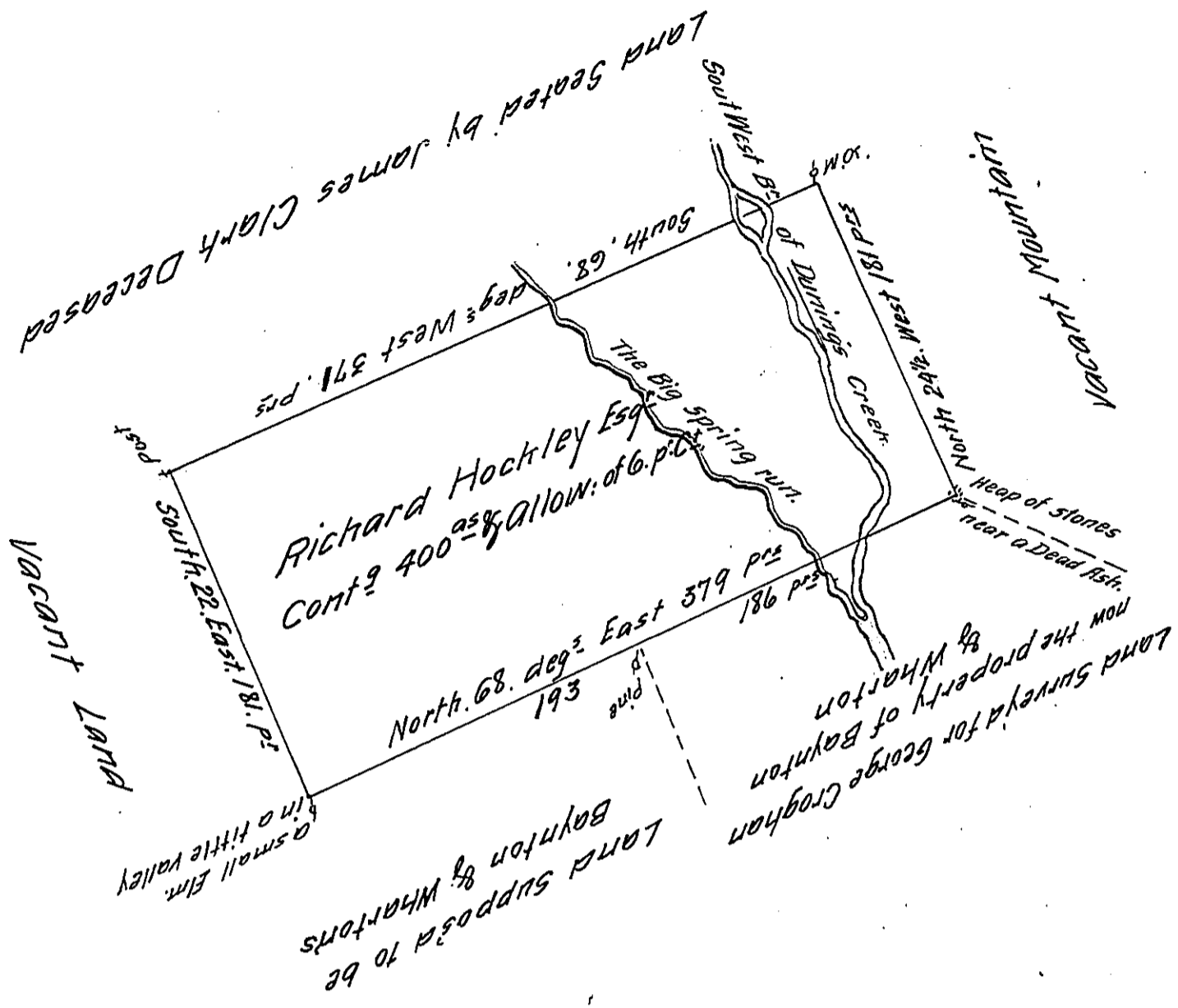

By Virtue of a Warrant of Resurvey Granted to Richard Hockley Esq: the Tenth Day of July 1762 and in pursuance of a Special Order from the Surveyor General Dated at Philad<sup>a</sup> October \_\_\_\_\_ the above described Tract of Land called the Savanna \_\_\_\_\_ in Cumberland County upon the South West Branch of Dunning's Creek a little above the forks of sd Creek Containing Four Hundred Acres and the usual Allowance of six p<sup>c</sup> Cent was Resurvey'd November the 6<sup>th</sup> 1767
