Situate on the north east side Sinne-mohoning Creek opposite and below the second forks, commonly called Bennets branch, and opposite the pre-emption survey made for General James Potter and including a salt well with a pump: in Clearfield County Chinglic lamoos township - Surveyed the 11th of March 1811 agreeably to directions from the Surveyor General in his letter of the 25th October 1810 for George Lattimore in pursuance of his Warrant dated 20th December 1786 No 797 Specially located by his attorney Thomas Burnside Esq^r dated March 1st 1810
