N.B. the part mark'd with yellow represents a piece which the Edwards's appear'd very desirous to Conceal between the above and Tho^s Edwards, but I could not think myself justified in so doing, as the Warrant of Thomas Edwards Calls to join Haverling, Debler & Hill in partnership
