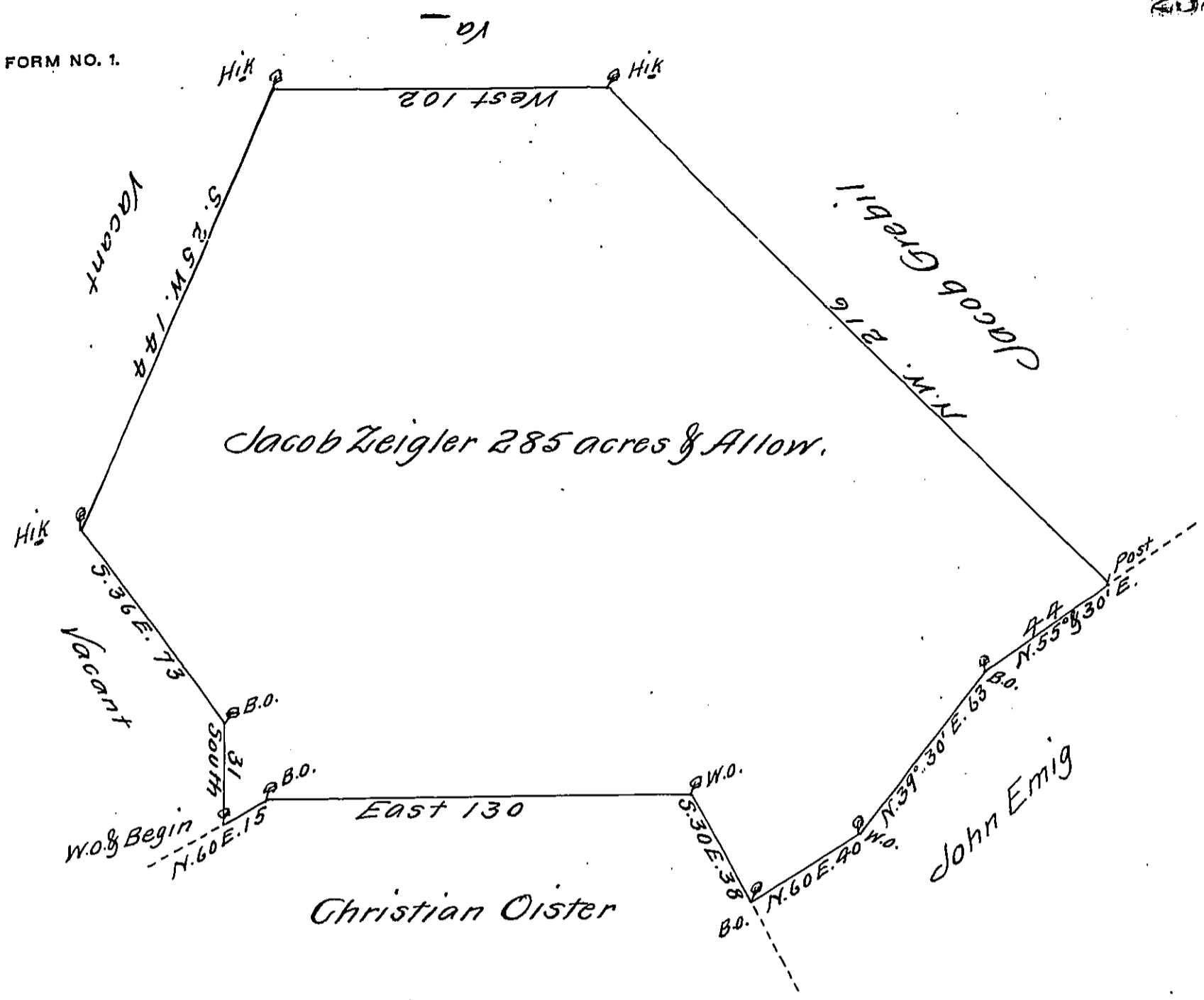


FORM NO. 1.



A Draught of a Tract of Land, Situate on the West Side of the River Sasquahannah in Manchester Township in the County of York (late part of the County of Lancaster) Part of the Mannor of Springetsbury Containing two Hundred and eighty five acres and the Allowance of Six Acres per Cent for Roads & High Ways. Surveyed the eight day of April 1746 for Jacob Zeigler by Thomas Cookson Esq^r. late Deputy Surveyor of Lancaster County, in pursuance of a License under the Hand of the Hon Thomas Penn Esq^r. one of the Proprietors &c. of the Province of Pennsylvania bearing date H at Lancaster the 30th October 1736 - the Lines examined, protracted & Calculated.
