



In pursuance of a Warrant of 400 acres granted to John Duffield dated the 30 day of May 1792 was surveyed on the 17 day of February 1830 the above described tract of land containing 338 acres 36 perches and allowance of six per Cent for roads &c. and that Johnathan Rhoades was residing on the same and there appeared upwards of 15 acres cleared fenced and (obl.) state of cultivation situate in Sadsbury Township Crawford County Pennsylvania
