



In pursuance of an act of Assembly passed the 12<sup>th</sup> Day of March 1783 for the sale of certain lands therein mentioned and by virtue of a Commission under the hand and seal of office of John Lukens Esquire Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania. to me directed bearing date at Philad<sup>a</sup> the 14<sup>th</sup> day of August 1783 the above tract of land containing two hundred & forty five acres forty five perches and Allowance of six per cent for roads &c was surveyed on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June 1785 by
