



A Draught of a tract of Land Situate in Pobl. Township in the County of York (late part of the County of Lancaster) containing two Hundred and forty eight Acres & an half and the allowance of Six Acres & Cent for Roads and Highways. Surveyed the 21<sup>st</sup> day of September 1793 by Thomas Cookson Esq<sup>r</sup> late Deputy Surveyor of Lancaster County for Johannes Dirdrff in pursuance of Warrant bearing Date at Philadelphia the 27<sup>th</sup> day of August 1792 Protracted from M<sup>r</sup> Cookson's Field Book & Calculated — To W<sup>m</sup> Parsons Esq<sup>r</sup> Surv<sup>r</sup> Gen<sup>c</sup> & Geo Stevenson one of the Exec<sup>r</sup> of Tho<sup>s</sup> Cookson Deced.
