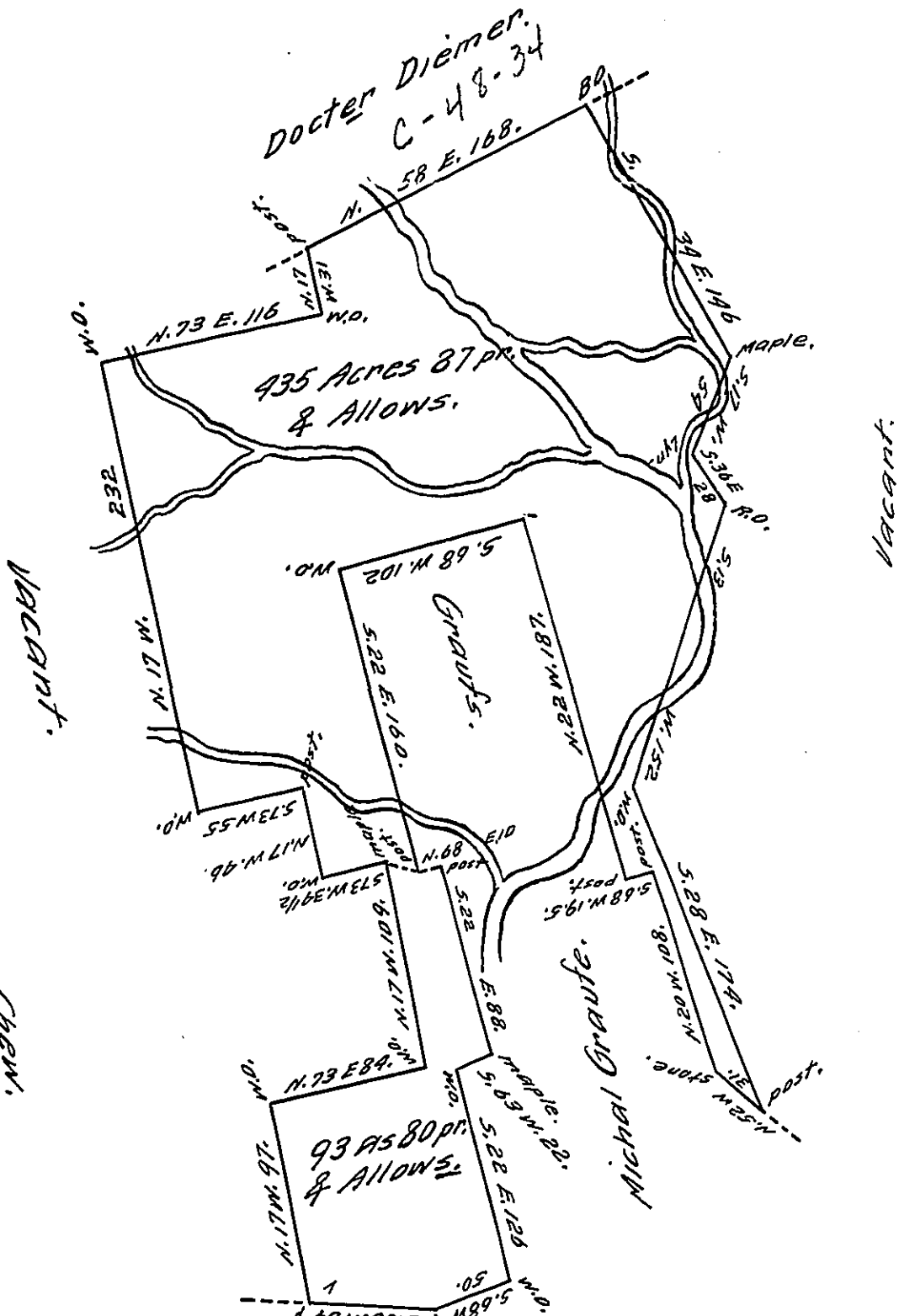


Note. the original survey here for Wm. Chew, was made in 1773.



That the above Tract of Land having been originally Surveyed for Benjn Chew Esqr. on the west Branch of fishing creek, and is now Resurveyed it is found that one line being along the Creek and at the foot of a precipice an error of several Degrees in the course had taken place in the original Survey by the correction of which error agreeably to the old marked corner the line extends much further Southwestward before it is intersected by Michal Grauss's line than formerly. And is now found to contain four hundred and thirty five Acres & 87 perches & all. Further on the west side the Surveys extended downwards till it is cut off by the intersection of Grauss land this being added to the Survey which it may be with propriety the whole Quantity then will be five hundred and twenty nine acres and seven perches & all.
