

On Application of Gen. Wm. Irvine Resolved that the Surveyor Gen. be directed to make Survey of the Island situated in the Ohio River below Pittsburgh, in the name & for the benefit of the said Gen. Wm. Irvine; Agreeably to <sup>an Act</sup> ~~Resolution~~ of the Gen. Assembly, bearing Date on the 24th. day of September, 1783 & entitaled "An Act to grant the right of Pre-emption to an Island known by the name of Montour's Island in the Ohio River, in Brigadier Gen. Wm. Irvine."
