Eliorer Dawson produced a certificate from the Com^{rs} for adjusting Titles and settling Claims to lands in the Counties of Yologa Monongalea and Ohio for Four hundred acres of land in this county on the waters of Redstone to include her settlement made in the year 1770 in right of herself during her natural life. The remainder to Nic^s Dawson Ex^r of George Dawson decd, to be distributed according to the Will of the said - George - Jan^y 21, 1780. Book No 1. fol^o 11.
