

The part marked John Latsha Containing 78<sup>ac</sup> was Surveyed to  
to him on the 25<sup>th</sup> of May 1827 in pursuance of his Warrant dated  
the 16<sup>th</sup> of May 1827.

And the small part included in a dotted line  
was Surveyed to Henry Shissler on the 15<sup>th</sup> of January 1828 by virtue  
of his Warrant dated the 27<sup>th</sup> Dec<sup>r</sup> 1827. - Containing 5 acres &c.

The line adjoining Philip Dunkleburger I found  
marked agreeing with the age of the adjoining Survey on the  
South which is Dunkleburgers Northern boundary. No line  
was marked agreeing with the age of Jackson's Survey made  
by W<sup>m</sup> Gray then D. S. of sd County. - I do presume the J. Jack-  
son tract was never Marked until the 26<sup>th</sup> Dec<sup>r</sup> 1828.
