



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in the Long-Swamp Township in the County of Berks and Province of Pennsylvania, Containing forty one Acres and 104 Perches of Land, together with the usual Allowance at six per Cent for Roads. That was formerly Surveyed unto Martin Margher in Pursuance of a Warrant granted unto him By the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Proprietaries, Dated at Philadelphia on the 16<sup>th</sup> Day of March Annoque Domini 1748/9. Resurveyed by Order of the Surveyor General on the 7<sup>th</sup> Day of June. Anno - 1765.
