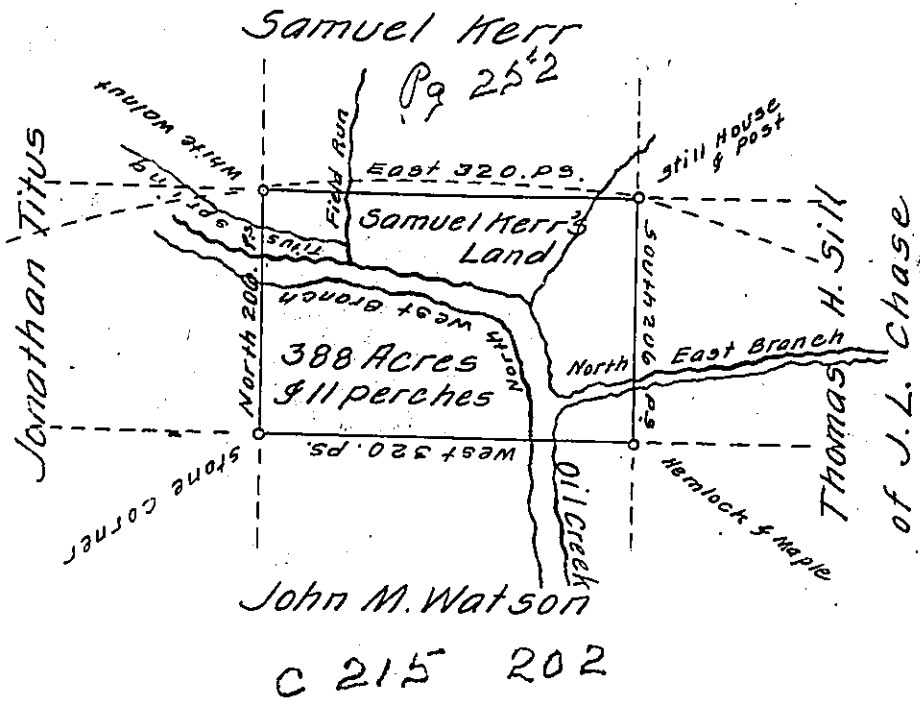


Samuel Kerr's Land
