Deceas'd. by his Receipt Dated thirteenth of April 1756. Assignment on the Back of the Receipt that a son of Jacob Rhods, Deceas'd did Assign his Right unto George Smith by the Name of Daniel Rhods. August 10<sup>th</sup> 1759. Containing one Hundred & one Acres and the allowance of 1/10<sup>th</sup> Cent. Taken from a Draught of James Scull. Dece. this 28 of September 1781.*
