



The Draught of a tract of land Situate in Howard township Centre County. Containing three hundred and thirty Seven Acres and allowance of Six per cent $\frac{1}{2}$ Surveyed the 10th day of March 1814. in pursuance of a warrant granted to Mordicai Livergood dated the 4th day of February A.D. 1814.

At the time of making the above Survey, Mordicai Livergood and family resided on the same, in a two story log house, stone Chimney, a small spring house, and about an Acre, or three quarters of an Acre of cleared Land.
