



The above described Tract of Land lies in the East End of East Nottingham Township near Great Elk River. Begins at a Black Oak-marked Tree standing on the East side of a Branch called Burdwell's Spring & runs thence N. 26 deg. W. 68 perches to a Black oak. thence S 75° W 58 perches to a heap of Stones in the middle of a great Road being the Place of Beginning for Phineas Hodgson's Maryland Patent, thence by Lines of the Same &c the several Courses & Distances above Described, laid down by a Scale of 50<sup>th</sup> to an Inch.
