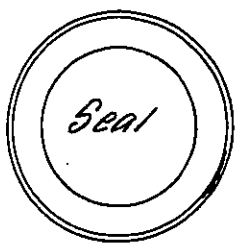

These are to authorize & require you to survey & lay out unto our Use the Quantity of Ten Thousand Acres of Land on the Allegheny River near & below Kittanning Town to begin at least half a Mile below and to proceed downwards and to make Return thereof into our Secretrys Office. For which this shall be your sufficient Warrant
