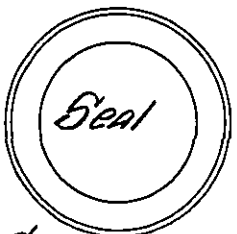

These are to authorize & require you to survey or cause to be surveyed for our Use in part of our tenths the Quantity of Five Thousand Acres of Land in several Tracts upon or between the waters of Conemaugh, Clearfield, Chest. Crooked & two Lick Creeks in the Counties of Bedford & Westmoreland and to make Return thereof for our Use into our Secretarys Office. For which this shall be your sufficient Warrant. Witness Richard Penn Esq<sup>r</sup> Lieutenant Governor & Commissioner of Property of the said Province who by virtue of certain powers from the said proprietaries hath hereunto set his Hand & caused the Seal of the Land Office to be affixed at Philadelphia this twenty third Day of July One thousand seven hundred & seventy three.
