



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Manchester Township York County within the Honourable the Proprietaries Manner of Springetsbury containing one hundred and Ninety three Acres and three Quarters of an Acre and the Allowance of six Acres P Cent for Roads and Highways Surveyed the 6th day of December 1752 for George Leviston, one hundred Acres part thereof in pursuance of a Lycense for two hundred and Fifty Acres granted by the Honourable Thomas Penn Esq^r to Michael Ramble bearing date the 30th day of October 1736 the Right whereof is now vested in George Leviston Ninety three Acres and three Quarters of an Acre the residue thereof in pursuance of the late Secretarys Orders.
