



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Heidelbergh Township in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania containing one Hundred and Forty Six Acres of Land together with the usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Roads. That was Surveyed unto Philip Hammel, on the 16<sup>th</sup> August Anno 1757 in Pursuance of a Warrant granted for the Same Tract unto Andrew Kauttman. Dated the 4<sup>th</sup> August Anno 1747. Who had sold his Right to the said Warrant with his Improvement unto Michael Letzinger for whose Depts the said Improvement was taken in Execution and sold by the Sheriff of the County unto Elias Bender who in the year 1753. Sold and Conveyed his Right to the same unto the above named Philip Hammel to whom the Land was Surveyd as above - the same being now sold to Jacob Freyman.
