



In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12th day of March 1783 for the sale of certain lands therein mentioned and by virtue of a Commission under the hand and seal of Office of John Lukens Esq^r Surveyor General for the state of Pennsylvania to me directed bearing Date at Philad.^a August the 14th 1783 the Above tract of land containing three hundred and forty four Acres and Eighteen Perches and Allowance of Six Percent for roads &c^a was Surveyed on the 20th day of July 1785 by
