



A draught of a tract of land called McBrides Hall situate on the east side of the north east branch of Susquehanna about three miles above Fort Augusta including a Run in the County of Northumberland containing ninety seven acres besides the usual allowance of 6  $\frac{1}{2}$  cent. for roads &c. Surveyed the 2<sup>d</sup> day of July 1772 for John Means in pursuance of an order dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769 number 540.
