



A draught of a tract of land called \_\_\_\_\_ situate on both sides of the path leading from Ellis Hughes at Catawassey to obliterated adjoining and between land surveyed for Thomas Barger and Edward Shippen Junr Esq in the County of Northumberland containing three hundred and fifty four acres and a half besides the usual allowance of 6  $\frac{1}{2}$  cent for roads &c. Surveyed the 9<sup>th</sup> day of June 1774 for Anthony Morris in pursuance of a warrant dated the 12 day of January 1774.
