



A draught of a tract of land called \_\_\_\_\_ situate on the South side of Towardia Creek adjoining land of James Torbitt and others in the County of Northumberland, now Luzerne, survey'd on the eleventh day of July 1785 for William Morrison by virtue of his warrant bearing date the first day of July 1784 containing four hundred and forty one acres and a half with the allowance of six  $\frac{1}{2}$  cent for roads &c.
