



The above are two surveys I made the beginning of Novem^r 1750 for John Hillman, at the request of John McMickle.

To the best of my remembrance McMickle obtain'd another warrant besides the one above mentioned, and having sold 150^{a.s.} ^{cont^d 197 1/4} part of the tract surveyed on the firstⁿ to one Mathew Rowe (tho Rowe has not that quantity) concluded to have the remainder with the addition, returned in one tract on the last warrant.
