



There was surveyed on the 5th day of March 1733 to Jacob Moyer a tract of land situate on a branch of Perkiorny in the County of Philadelphia, begining at a post a corner of Margeret Shippens land thence by vacant land south East one hundred & twelve perches to a white oak markt for a corner thence by vacant land South West one hundred & fifty one perches to a post thence by vacant land North West one hundred and twelve perches to a post in the line of the said Margeret Shippens land thence by the same North East one hundred fifty one perches to the place of begining containing one hundred acres with usual allowance
