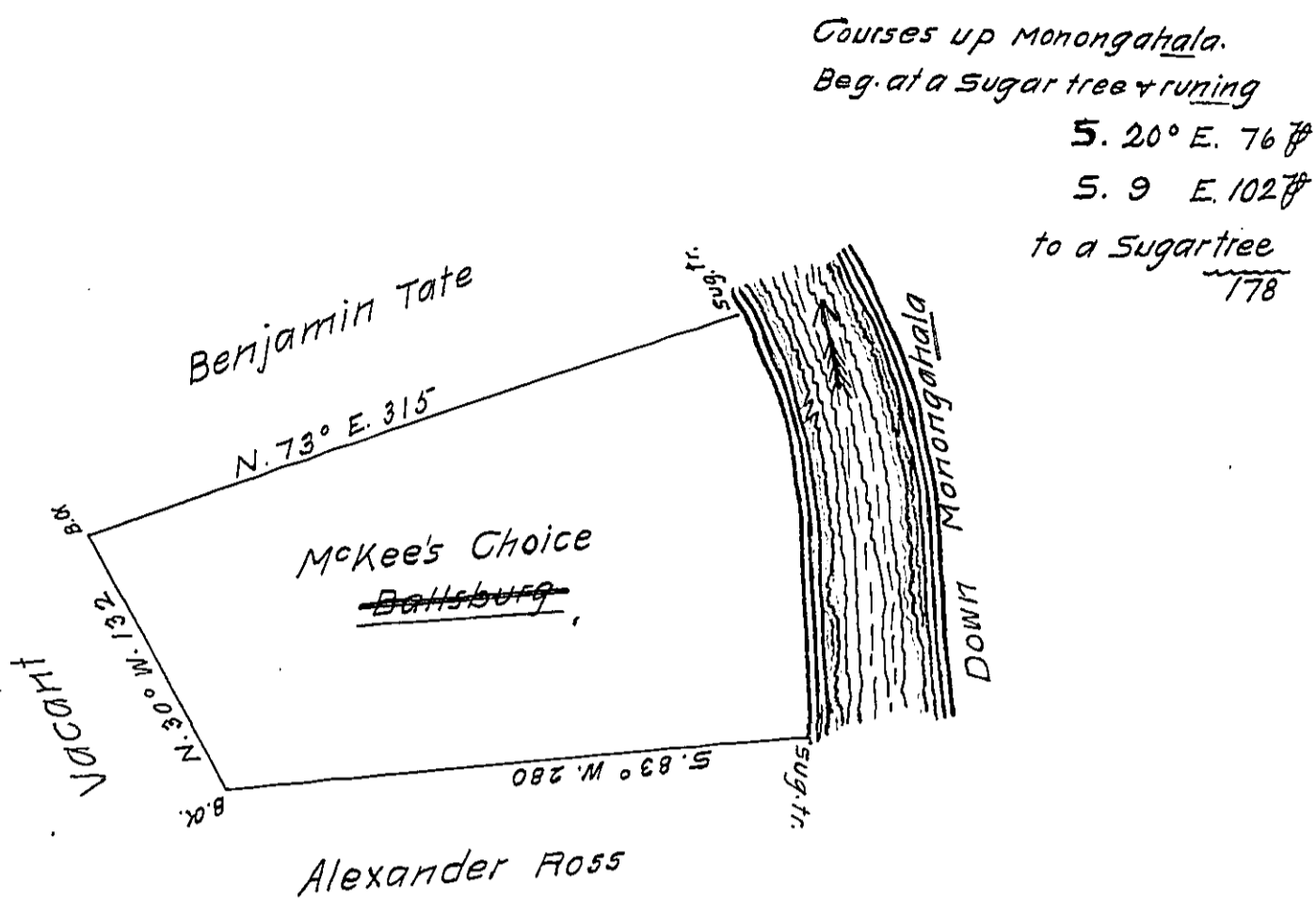


FORM NO. 1.



In pursuance of an order No 3130 dated 20<sup>th</sup> April 1769, the above is a draught of a tract of land called Ballsburg situated on the West side Monongahala containing 268-2-20bl. acres with the usual allowance of 6 ff. G. for roads, highways &c. Survey'd for George England 25<sup>th</sup> November 1769.

The above land is adjudged to John Brownfield's Assignee John McKee by judgment of the Board dated the 25<sup>th</sup> February 1772.
