



In pursuance of a warrant dated 13th Feb^y 1773 surveyd for William Martin Jun^r the above described tract of land (called Nimrod) containing two hundred acres with an allowance proportioned to 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ cent situate about two miles North from Forbes's old road on a branch of Turtle Creek including the improvement by an Old Fort now Westmoreland County surveyd 15th March 1773 $\frac{1}{2}$
