



By virtue of an application to William Davies dated 21st May 1766 No 1518 the above described tract of land situate at the back of the Tuscarora Mountain in Brunswick township Berks County containing 313 3/4^{ac} & allowance of Six pr. Ct for roads &c called Wolf Bottom was surveyed the 3rd day of December 1767 by Mordecai Yarnal (who surveyed under John or Jasper Scull) copied from his fieldworks the 2nd day of the 12 mo. 1784
