



A draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Mearatamny Township in the County of Berks (formerly Philadelphia) in the Province of Pennsylvania, containing Fifty one acres and 80 Perches of Land together with the usual allowance at six per cent for Roads, that was formerly surveyed by Edward Scull unto Conrad Bather (al. Pander or Panther) in pursuance of a warrant granted to him by the Honble. Proprietaries Dated on the 27th day of March Anno. 1745.
