Containing One thousand and Thirteen Acres and One hundred and Three perches with the usual allowance of six per. Cent for Roads. Surveyed for Timothy Pickering, Samuel Hodgdon, Duncan Ingraham Junr. and Tench Coxe the 8<sup>th</sup> Day of June 1786 In pursuance of a Warrant Dated May 17<sup>th</sup> 1785 No. 564.
